Esther Howard Enduring Truth Award

The Esther Howard Enduring Truth Award is a distinguished honor presented to students who have shown extraordinary perseverance, discipline, and devotion by completing four qualifying Christian Service events. Named in tribute to Esther Howard—whose unwavering faith, deep love for Scripture, and lifelong commitment to passing on God’s Word have inspired generations—this award honors not only the accomplishment of memorization but also the enduring impact of God’s truth written on the hearts of young Believers.

Recipients of this award embody Psalm 119:11, *“Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.”* They stand as examples of spiritual dedication, reminding us that when God’s Word is deeply rooted within us, it transforms our lives and equips us for every good work.

This is more than a memory milestone—it is a legacy of faithfulness.

Award Qualifications:

1. To qualify for the Esther Howard Enduring Truth Award, students must complete four of the following Christian Service events over the course of their participation in Regional Student Convention or International Student Convention:
 - Christian Soldier Award
 - Christian Worker Award
 - Golden Apple Award
 - Golden Lamb Award
 - Golden Harp Award
 - Scribe’s Award
2. Students are eligible to receive the Esther Howard Enduring Truth Award **once at a Regional Student Convention** and **once at an International Student Convention** after completing their fourth Christian Service Award.
3. Students may earn multiple Christian Service Awards within a single year toward qualifying for the Esther Howard Enduring Truth Award.
4. Participation in Christian Service events does not need to occur in consecutive years to be eligible for the award.
5. An Affidavit (CF30B) must be submitted to Master Control on registration day to verify entry.
